



Inpatient School in the Seacrest Studio

Process:

- Worked with Studio Team to agree upon daily 1-hour time slot
- Opportunities to connect with other Seacrest Studio collaborators and plan lessons accordingly (Children's Museum of Denver, Denver Zoo, Denver Aquarium Etc)
- School is advertised to patients and families with regularly updated flyers, BBOY45 commercial slides, and mentioned by Studio Team throughout daily broadcasts
- o Therapy Teams are sent weekly lessons details to encourage participation with their patients

Planning:

- Teachers collaborate regularly and share lesson planning responsibilities
- Weekly themes alternate bi-weekly from lower elementary content (K-2) to upper (3-5)
- Lessons sent to various rehab groups on the Thursday prior (SLP, OT, PT, and/or neuropsychologist will treat patients bedside during studio school)
- Executive Functioning Skills are emphasized throughout the week for rehab populations
- Core skills targeted daily (math, reading, language, and STEM are regularly emphasized)
- o School BINGO Tuesdays with prizes to increase engagement and patient interest in studio school
- o Visuals: anchor Charts, manipulatives, videos, read alouds, completed teacher examples

Create and group resources:

 School team members are grouping resources used during the week to create "grab and go" lesson plans and activities for future use

Distribute materials:

- Every morning materials are delivered to rehab school program patients and other identified school patients throughout the hospital
- Detailed instruction forms (Get Ready, Do, Done) are created and sent with materials to patient rooms in case patients are not able to follow along but would like to complete the activity later
- Additional material bags are prepped for patients who call down for supplies during live broadcast

Live Broadcast:

o Patients encouraged to call down and participate on air throughout broadcast

Patient Follow Up:

- o In person and via google classroom modules for BI population
- Children/Families can send pictures, videos, and/or their finished product to be shared hospital wide by school team and studio staff
